"Uncle Dan" Cunningham, who once gained national prominence when he led a force of 85 deputies to victory in a pitched battle with 300 lawbreakers, ended Thursday afternoon with the death of the 92 year old retired officer at his home in Charleston. Cunningham, veteran of many a dangerous brush with outlaws of West Virginia, had served as a deputy US Marshall, city detective, game warden, railroad policeman and juvenile officer. He retired April 15, 1933.

The famous exploits of the man who began his career as a school teacher occurred in 1904. Cunningham, then a deputy US Marshall, was sent to Adkinsville, a mile south of Beckley, to arrest men charged with tearing up the tracks of the Chesapeake and Ohio railroad. When he arrived, he found 50 men at the post office, all of them armed with rifles, and was told he could serve no warrants in that town. He returned to Beckley and went back to Adkinsville on the next day, but was unable to find the men he sought. On the third day, February 22, 1903, a gang of 300 men crossed the bridge at Adkinsville and Cunningham received a report they were tearing up the railroad tracks at Piney Creek. Cunningham was ordered to arrest the group, so he deputized 85 men. The two forces met at Stanford City, a pitched battle ensued and several were killed or wounded. When the conflict was over, Cunningham, had nearly 200 guns and 68 prisoners.

He also had an unusual record of ferreting out and confiscating "moonshine" whiskey stills, and one of those he captured was placed in Smithsonian Institute in Washington.

Cunningham was born in a log cabin on Beech Fork, Jackson County, and received his schooling by walking to classes four miles each way every day. While still in his teens, he began teaching in Jackson, Putnam and Kanawha counties.

He served 16 years as a deputy US Marshall and subsequently became a city detective at Charleston. He quit to become a railroad policeman, then again joined the city police department. Cunningham also served as a game warden. In later years he devoted most of his time in juvenile cases. His widow, two sons and one daughter survive. (Jackson Herald, Friday, 13 Feb 1942)
