The list of war dead for Jackson County reached fifty-eight last Thursday morning when Mrs. Glada Skeen, of Ripley, was notified by the War Department that her husband, **Pvt. Donald Skeen** had been killed in a train accident in France on January 17. Pvt. Skeen was a farmer in the Murraysville community of the county before entering the service several months ago. He had been overseas only a few days at the time he was killed. He was 35 years old, a native of the Kentuck community where his father, W. D. Skeen, still resides. His wife is the former Glada Carpenter of Gay. They have three children, Louree, Anita and Larry. In addition to his wife and three children and his father, other survivors include, Warrent Officer Glenn Skeen of North Carolina, Cpl. Claude Skeen in California, Denzil Skeen in California, Mrs. Mildred Boykin of Detroit, Michigan, Mrs. Auvil Chancey of Charleston, Roderick and Arlene Skeen, Charleston, and Colleen and Randall Skeen, of Kentuck. Services for **Pfc. Donald Avon Skeen**, 35, who before he entered the service during the late war, was a Grant District farmer, were held Sunday afternoon from the Goshen Church at Kentuck and burial was in the church cemetery with military honors. The body arrived at the Vail Mortuary in Ripley last Friday. Rev. Roy W. Skeen of the Ripley EUB Church officiated at the service. Pfc. Skeen was killed at Encaux, France on January 17, 1945, just seventeen days after he left the states with a contingent headed for the battle front of Europe. A-1. David Casto, Sr., born 1721 in New Jersey, died about 1770 in Berkeley Co., (now Upshur Co.,) (West) Virginia. David left Turkey Fork, Downe Township, north of Egg Island, and traveled to Fairfield Township, Cumberland County, South Jersey, to accompany Phebe Gandy to a Baptist Church at Cape May Courthouse, New Jersey where on 17 Aug 1752 he married Phoebe Gandy born 1736 in New Jersey, died about 1770 in Berkeley Co., (West) Virginia, daughter of Thomas Gandy. They returned to Turkey Point and established a home at Downe Township, north of Egg Island. A baptismal record for David and Phebe were found dated 1765 at the Dividing Creek Baptist Church, Downe Township, New Jersey. By this time they had at least five children.

The urge to move on to "new land" was great, so taking his wife and children, David traveled north to Salem, New Jersey, then took the Great Wagon Road at York, Pennsylvania and crossed the Patomac River into Hampshire County, (West) Virginia. A heart attack last Thursday morning was fatal to **Archibald Alonzo Reynolds**, 79 year old farmer and businessman, of Evans, as he sat in the home after returning from the fields where he had gone to work that morning. Dr. T. E. Rymer said that death caused from a severe heart attack and that death had been sudden.
