F. A. Casto, well known Ripley business man and a merchant of many years experience, died at a hospital in Ripley last Saturday morning about eleven o'clock as the result of an infection of the foot. His condition was critical from Saturday afternoon until Sunday morning when he died. The funeral services were held at the Ripley

United Brethren Church Tuesday afternoon at two o'clock with the Rev. Fred Slaughter in charge and burial was in the Shinn cemetery at Fairplain. Mr. Casto had been an active member of the church for many years and was a trustee at the time of his death. On numerous occasions he had served as the superintendent of the Sunday school and was active in all the affairs of the church and the denomination.

For many years he operated a farm and engaged in the mercantile business at Staats Mills. Later he came to Ripley where he was engaged in the same business until a few days ago when he sold his store on the West Side to Ola Bush and retired to his farm below town where he had hoped to rest and outdoor work he could regain his health which began to fail him last fall.
