After several weeks illness due to infirmities that accompany old age, Mrs. Alexis F. Parsons, wife of A. F. Parsons, Sr., deceased, passed from among the living at the home of her son, Lovell M. Parsons, on Parchment, Thursday, February 6th, 1919. Alexis Fink Parsons, her husband, was one of the most widely known and prominent farmers of this county in his day and died March 17th, 1895. Since the death of her husband, Mrs. Parsons made her home with her son, Lovell M. Parsons. Phoebe Casto Parsons, daughter of Benjamin and Sarah Casto, was born on Parchment, near the site of her demise, on August 10th, 1830, her father being one of the first settlers in what was then Mason County, Virginia. Her education, like most persons of that time, was limited. She

attended the community;s "Old Field's School", provided by the state of Virginia, which offered each child four months of school for three successive years free gratis. The rest of her time was employed using the spinning wheel or loom and in knitting, or the manufacturing of clothes for the family and market. She learned the art of cookery early in life before an open firplace which occupied one entire end of the cabin. She was a great reader, always taking an interest in current events until the last few years and her evening chats concerning incidents happening during the administration of twenty or more of the presidents was a source of pleasure to her grandchildren and great grandchildren, to whom she delighted to tell them. Hon. Virgil A. Lewis, one time State historian, was a visitor to her home on several occasions during his tenure of office to obtain data on lost history which he could not get in any other way, and was heard to make a complimentary remarks about her clear memory concerning events of our pioneer history.

She was united in marriage with Alexis Fink Parsons on March 30, 1848, by Rev. Andrew Warner of the United Brethren church. To this union were born fourteen children, ten sons and four daughters, one son and one daughter dying in infancy. Twelve children were reared to manhood and womanhood, were married, raised families and three of them preceded her to the great beyond - Willim Q. Parsons, Mrs. Ellen Shatto and Alexius Chapman Parsons, all of whom resided in this county at the time of their deaths. The children now living are Mrs. Flora Jane Kessel, of Given, Lewis F. Parsons, of Ripley, Route 2, Mrs. Susan Ellison of Ripley, Richard O. Parsons of Rockcastle, John B. Parsons of Rockcastle, Austin L. Parsons of Parkersburg, Lovell M. Parsons of Ripley, Okey J. Parsons of Ripley, O. D. Parsons of Akron, Ohio. To her twelve children were born seventy-seven children; to these grandchildren were born one hundred thirty-eight, to there great grandchildren were born two children, which are Mrs. Parsons' great great grandchildren. Besides the above relatives she is survived by the following brothers and sisters; Solomon Casto of Pomeroy, Ohio, Enoch Casto of Elmwood, Mrs. Lucretia Barnett Oldham, of Rockcastle, Alexander Casto of Evans.

She had several relatives who served as soldiers in all the wars, in which our country participated. The following grandsons and great grandsons are now in France: Grandson, Sergeant Howard Parsons, 314th Field Artillery; Lieutenant Norman Parsons, Marines; Corporal D. M. Dorsey 314th Field Artillery. Great-grandsons: Lieutenant Ray Kessel, 153rd Pioneer Infantry; Lieutenant Floyd M. Sayre, 314th Field Artillery; Sergeant Otho Harrsion, Field Artillery; Corporal Boyd Parsons, U.S. Engineers; Corporal Harry Kessel, Field Artillery. She was converted to christianity in early life and joined the United Brethren church, of which she and her husband were faithful and substantial members for more than half century.

Mr. and Mrs. Parsons, with such people as the late Mr. and Mrs. George Shinn, and others we might mention, were the pillars of the foundations of the community. (some of the article is missing) Her funeral was conducted at Mount Mariah U.B. Church with the Rev. T. H. Rymer and the Rev. H. K. Riffe and her body was laid to rest beside that of her devoted husband in teh cemetery nearby to await the resurrection. The floral tributes were very beautiful, among them a large boquet of white carnations bestowed by the Bank of Ripley, of which her husband was a charter director and her son is now vice-president.

Thus passes from this life after the lapse of nearly a century, a most excellent wife, devoted mother, good grandmother, an interesting great great greatdmother, and exceptionally interesting great great grandmother, and above all, a christian who has lived the life of a good woman for therr-fourths of a century. A three day search in the vacinity of Parkersburg (WV), for J. Weston Parsons, 64 year old native and former resident of Evans, ended Monday morning when an attendent at the locks on the Ohio River at Vienna, discovered the body. A wife search had been made Saturday and Sunday with no clures found. Parsons started out from his home in Vienna Friday morning about ten o'clock to visit his daughter and was not seen thereafter. When he died not return to his home Friday afternoon, relatives started a search for him, which they were assisted by State Police, PArkersburg city police, County officers and the newspapers. Two brothers of the man were in Ripley Sunday and checked with relatives in this viinity but found that he had visited none of them. The river was dregged Saturday by County officials, but no body was found. After the body was taken from the river Monday morning, relatives in Ripley and nearby sections, were notified that the funeral services would be held at the home at five o'clock Monday evening. The body was brought to Ripley and taken to Otterbein cemetery, where it was interred late Monday evening. Mr. Parsons was born in Jackson county and was formerly employed at the Vetrolite Plant. For aiding in capturing seventeen prisoners and saving the lives of three wounded men under constant machine gun fire, Orville G. Kessel, of Ripley, has been recommended for the Silver Star Medal, the Soldier Medal and Technical Sergeant rating. Kessel is being treated at Stark General Hospital, Charleston, South Carolina, prior to his transfer to another hospital. On July 28, 1944, Kessel and another man were guarding a road block in Normandy when seven Germans came down the road. Kessel fired his automatic rifle, killing two of the enemy and forcing the other five to surender. Just then, twelve more Germans came along, but they surrendered immediately thinking they were outnumbered. This combat patrol was found to have many machine guns and machine pistols among its weapons. Because of this action, Kessel was recommended for the Silver Star by his battalion commander.

Two weeks later, on August 9, after the push from Normandy had begun, Kessel once more earned himself honors. His outfit, the 10th Infantry Regiment, had been led into a trap by the Natzis. The 10th had been allowed to take three hedgerows in order to lead them into flanking crossfire. About one quarter of the trapped men were killed or wounded. Kessel and two others went to pull the wounded out before the Germans completed the job.

Crawling under spewing hail of machine gun bullets, Kessel reached the first casualty and discovered that the man would have to be carried back. Picking the man up, Kessel placed him on his back and ran desperately for cover. He safely made it. Kessel returned and dragged another man out. Once more he ran back to save a buddy. This time the Germans had Kessel in their sights, and he could feel the deadly lead tearing through his fatigues. Several times he thought he was mortally wounded, but he kept going until he reached safety. Only then died he pause to regain his strength and see how he had fared. Bullets tore up his clothing and the raincoat attached to his belt, but he had escaped injury. For bravery above and beyond the call of duty, Kessel has been recommended for the Soldier's Medal.

Kessel joined the Army in 1934 and received training in teh cavlry, field artillery and infantry. He was sent to build bases in Iceland in 1941 and from there he ws transferred to Ireland in 1943. His section of the 10th landed in Normandy a month after D-Day. Several days later he was wounded in the knee by fragments from an 88mm shell but he refused to return to a hospital. On August 1, he was hit in the arm and leg while attacking in the Normandy breakthrough. Once more he refused to return to the rear lines.

On August 10, at Fourgeres, Kessel was hit in the hips and arm, but he stayed on combat duty. In September, Kessel was among the first troops in the Third Army to cross the German border, but several days later his outfit was pulled back to join in the fierce fighting along the Mosel River. There the 10th encountered bitter opposition, and because they had no replacements available, they suffered severe losses. This time Kessel was badly hit in the hips by shellfire, and his fighting days were over. While in this action Kessel had to take over his platoon. He has been recommended for a platoon leader's rating of technical sergeant. He is the son of Mrs. Belva L. Kessel of Ripley, Route 2. (Jackson Herald, Friday, 5 Jan 1945)

Lovell M. Parsons, Sr., widely known farmer and business man of Ripley, died at the St. Joseph's Hospital in Parkersburg Monday afternoon at five-thirty o'clock following an illness of only a few hours. He would have celebrated his seventy-sixth birth day this coming Sunday and Mrs. Parsons had planned a birthday dinner in his honor and all the children were to be guests at the dinner. Mr. Parsons was out in town as susal Saturday but soon after he returned home Saturday evening he suffered a severe chill and by seven o'clock his condition was serious. Throughout the night his condition became noticably worse and Dr. T. L. Harris of Parkersburg was called Sunday to consult with the local physician on the case and he was taken to the Parkersburg hospital Sunday afternoon. There was no hope for his recovery at the time but everything possible was done to prolong his life. Dr. T. E. Rymer said that his death was due to uremic poisoning which was followed by pneumonia. He said that he was first called to the home Saturday evening about seven o'clock and that it was apparent at that time that pneumonia was developing. He said that the patient was only partially conscious early Sunday monring and that a desperate but losing fight was strted against the encroachment of the disease. He was born in Mason County in a section which was later to become Jackson County in 1867, the son of the late Alexis Fink and Phoebe Casto Parsons. His great grandfatherwas the original settler at Ripley, Captain William Parsons, and his grandfather, also named William Parsons, ws the first white child born at Ripley. The family later moved to Parchment at the site where his son, L. M. Parsons, Jr. resides and it was there that he built up one of the best known stock farms in the state. In addition to the widow, he leaves six children, T. Clayton Parsons, cashier of the Bank of Ripley; Alexis F. Parsons of Parkersburg, L. M. Parsons, Jr. president if the County Farm Bureau; W. King Parsons, member of the faculty of Gilmore High School, Frederick W. D. Parsons, county agricultural agent of Braxton County, and Mrs. D. M. Dorsey, wife of the pastor of the Baptist Church at Welch. Three brothers, A. L. of Parkersburg, O. D. of Akron, Ohio, and O. J. of Ripley, and one sister, Mrs. Susan Ellison of Ripley, also survive. Mr. Parsons saw to it that each of his children had a splended education to start out in life and gave each of them a farm of two hundred acres or more, or money equivalent and assisted each of them in getting started in housekeeping. He was public spirited and gave much of his time, effort and money to the cause of advancing the community. He was one of the prime movers in the building of the Ripley United Brethren Church, ourchased the materials and supervised the work, all without pay and was a heavy contributor to the cost. He was one of the leaders in the good roads movement in the county, the erection of a high school building in Ripley and helped establish and promote the first telephone and electric power lines into his home community on Parchment. Soon after the death of his father, who was a charter stockholder in the Bank of Ripley, he purchased his father's stock and was made a director, later vice president and for many years after the death of Warren Miller, served as president of the bank. He was very successful in business throughout his entire career. He started out as a renter in a barn which was transformed into a dwelling house and during his lifetime amassed considerable property. He purchased the land in West Ripley many years ago and had it marked off into lots and was instrumental in the development of that section of his home town. His first wife was Cordelia Staats who was the mother of the first two surviving children named above. Several years after her death he married Miss Mary King, a daughter of the late G. S. M. King, who was the Civil War sheriff of the county. After spending many years on the Parchment farm he and his wife decided to spend the evening time of their lives in Ripley and purchased the George B. Crow home ehre in the early twenties and they have since resided there. He was widely known throughout the state as a fancier of Hereford cattle and buyers and breeders came from widely separated sections of the county to see his heard and to buy herd stock from him. He never lost interest in his business until the time of his death and reamined active until just a few hours febore the end. The funeral services were held from the Ripley United Brethren Church Wednesday after noon at two o'clock with the Rev. L. R. Mahoney in charge, assisted by Rev. T. L. Miles and Rev. Fred Slaughter, and the body was taken to the Fairplain cemetery for burial. the Vail Mortuary had charge of the arrangements.
