A Ripley native lost his life Friday evening in a motorized four-wheeler accident which occurred off of Log Lick Road near Cottageville. **Ralph H. Ferguson**, 69, who now resides at Route 1, Gallipolis, was claimed in the 8 p.m. mishap. Ripley state police said that Ferguson was riding a 1986 Honda 4x4 ATV down a trail when the four-wheeler slipped off into a washed-out area along the trail's left side and flipped over, landing on top of Ferguson. A county ambulance and the Cottageville Volunteer Fire Department were dispatched to the scene but Ferguson was dead upon their arrival. His body was taken to the state medical examiner's office in South Charleston and officials stated that Ferguson apparently suffered a broken neck. Ferguson had been riding with a friend, Michael Arthur Bowlin of Racine, Ohio, who was on another four-wheeler and witnessed the mishap. The mishap occurred on property reportedly owned by Ferguson. Bowlin said that the pair was about to wind up riding for the evening and were enroute back to Ferguson's truck when the wreck happened. Because of the rural proximity of the accident site, Ferguson's body had to be removed from the scene and transported through brush and down an incline to the ambulance in a four-wheel drive truck driven by Cottageville fire chief Sonny Fox. State trooper Mike Comer and John Miller investigated. Damage to Ferguson's four-wheeler was estimated at \$350.

Ferguson and his wife of 49 years, Ruby Morris Ferguson, lived for years in the Ripley area. In January, their son, Mile, was fatally stricken by a stroke. Mike, at the time of his death, was listed as wishing to be an organ donor. Such was done, and the January 24 HERALD feathured the happy ending to his wishes being carried out, as his liver, two kidneys and both eye corneas were all donated and went to the enhance the physical condition of five other persons.

Ralph Ferguson was born in Ripley, a son of the late Richard and Vena Harpold Ferguson. He was a retired meatcutter from Johnson' Supermarkets and attended the First Baptist Church of the Nazarene in Gallipolis. A heart attack claimed the life of **C. C. Staats** one of Ripley's best known and generally most beloved citizens last Thursday evening about 8 o'clock at his home on Church Street. He was ill less than thirty minutes. Mr. Staats had spent the day in town as usual and had met with members of his Croquet Club at the old Fairgrounds late Thursday afternoon and had played until about dark. He came back to his home and was there only a short time when he complained to members of his family that he was feeling ill. Dr. E. D. Staats, his son, was not at the home at the time and Dr. T. E. Rymer rushed there but found that the man was dying and despite his efforts death came within a few minutes. His sudden death left his many friends here and elsewhere stunned and all day Friday and Saturday and up until noon Sunday there was a constant stream of friends going in and out of the home who had gone there to pay their last respects. He had experienced a heart attack last spring but recovered from it and there was no warning Thursday that a fatal attack was near. T. Clayton Parsons read the following obituary at the funeral Sunday:

Cornelius C. Staats, son of Enoch Staats, Sr. and Louise Casto Staats, was born at Staats Mills on February 21, 1874, died October 17, 1935, aged 61 years, seven months and 27 days. Thus ended a life that was spent in a busy and useful career and that gave an abundance of service to humanity. He was united in marriage to Miss Bessie E. Carson, the only daughter of the late A. M. and Mrs. Carson, on April 14, 1898 (she was born in Meigs County, Ohio) and to this union was born the following children: Mrs. Hayden Maddox of Morgantown, Dr. E. D. Staats and Wallace Waid Staats, both of Ripley. In addition to his wife and children, he is survived by the following brothers and sisters: Theodore Staats of Reedy, W. E. Staats of Ripley, Mrs. Rosa Rardin of Chicago, Illinois, Ms. Allen Shinn, Mrs. C. R. Kessel, both of Ripley, and Mrs. R. R. Vance of Parkersburg.

He was a kind and considerate husband and father, to him the welfare of his family was upper-most in his mind. He lived a Godly life before them and he saw that they always had the best training educationally and was always looking after their interest and well being.

On Noon Sunday the body was taken from the home to the Ripley United Brethren Church where it lay in state until 2 o'clock when the funeral service was conducted by Dr. Fred Slaughter, with Rev. T. L. Miles, a former pastor of the church, and Rev. J. R. Withrow, pastor of the Epworth Church and a close friend of the deceased, assisting T. Clayton Parsons, a close friend who read the obituary. George N. Casto, 71 years old and a former deputy clerk, died at his home in Ripley at five o'clock last Friday morning. His condition had been serious for several days from heart disease. Mr. Casto was one of the county's well known and most beloved citizens. His death was a blow to his many friends in every section of the county because many of them had not heard of his illness which was for only a few days. Born on a farm in Washington district, the son of a pioneer settler there, George N. Casto spent his boyhood days as a farmboy and at an early age was given a teacher's certificate. For many years he was one of the leading teachers of the county, was always active in the work of the profession and the greater part of his teaching experience was confined to his home section of the county.

He served as a deputy sheriff in Washington district during the time the late R. P. Shinn was sheriff of the county and sometime later he came to Ripley to become deputy clerk of the County Court during the term of the late C. C. Staats. He continued to serve in that capacity during the remainder of Mr. Staats term and for twelve years following, he served in the same capacity under Enoch Staats during both terms. After his term of office expired on December 31, 1932, he retired to his home here to spend the remainder of his days in peace and quietness and often said after he laid down the cares of public office that he was extremely happy.

He was a member of the Ripley United Brethren Church and had served in many official capacities in both the church organization and the Sunday School and was treasurer of the latter at the time of his death. The funeral services were held at the Ripley United Brethren Church Sunday afternoon at two o'clock under the directions of Rev. Fred Slaughter and undertakers Vail and Mills. Interment was in the Pine Hill cemetery. The following obituary was read by T. Clayton Parsons, who had long been associated with Mr. Casto in church and Sunday School work.

George N. Casto, son of Nicholas and Telitha Casto, was born at Staats Mills, March 21, 1865, and at his death, which occurred April 17, 1936, was 71 years and 26 days old. He was united in marriage to Miss Esther Catherine Scarberry on December 25, 1888. Three children were born to this union; Oley Casto of St. Paul, Minnesota, Warren Casto of Akron, Ohio, and Everett Casto, who died May 13, 1921. His grandchildren are: Mary, Geraldine, Gladys, Charles T., George C., and Charles Gilbert Casto. His parents were among the early pioneers of this county, the father being one of the pioneer ministers. Coming from a good home like this one, Mr. Casto, from youth had a wholesome influence on those with whom he associated. He became a Christian in early manhood and united with the United Brethren Church at Beech Grove. When he came to Ripley to reside, he brought his membership to the Ripley United Brethren Church, where he has been one of its most faithful and substantial members and officials during these twenty-one (21) years. He had been a member of the IOOF for forty (40) years. He has had a long and honorable career in the public affairs of the county, having served as Justice of the Peace, Member of the Board of Education, Deputy Sheriff of Washington District, and was for 17 years Deputy County Clerk of Jackson County, which service brought him in contact with most of the citizens of the county, to whom he was well and favorably known. His friends in the county were legion as a result of this long and faithful service to its citizens. He is survived by his wife, two sons, six grandchildren and the following brothers and sisters: A. The many friends of **Dr. Virgil L. Casto**, Ripley physician who died at his home here last Thursday morning, gathered at the Ripley United Brethren Church last Saturday afternoon to attend the services being held under the directions of Rev. Fred Slaughter, pastor of the church and a close friend of the family. Dr. Casto had been confined to his home on account of an illness since last December when he fell on the icy pavement between his home and office and fractured a hip. The injury sapped his strength and he gradually became weaker. Death had been expected for several days. The body was taken to the Fairplain cemetery for burial. The following obituary was read at the funeral and sets out the steps of his career.

Dr. Virgil L. Casto, son of Dr. James C. and Sarah Bradley Casto, was born March 18, 1864 and died August 6, 1936, being 72 years, 4 months and 18 days at his death. He had two brothers and three sisters, all of whom are dead except Dr. Holly W. Casto of Ravenswood. His grandfather was Rev. George Casto, one of the earliest white settlers of Jackson County and who founded a home at Staats Mills about the year 1811. He was married to Mollie A. Skidmore, September 20, 1888 and four children were born to them of whom two are now living, Dr. Wendell E. Casto and Mrs. W. King Parsons, who both reside in Ripley, and with the widow were at his bedside during his long period of illness, doing what they could to help alleviate his suffering.

Dr. Casto was an outstanding churchman and christian gentleman throughout his life, an exemplified the characteristics of his family in a splendid way. Rev. George Casto, his grandfather, and Dr. James C. Casto, his father, were both licensed ministers in the Methodist Protestant Church, from which he transferred his membership to the Ripley United Brethren Church, where he had worshiped all these years and took an active and prominent part in its affairs. During this time he has held every office within the gift of the church and served with distinction. He was a member of the Board of Trustees that erected the present church building a few years ago and was one of the most liberal contributors on eth same, but he most loved his position as the teacher of the Ladies Bible Class of the Sunday School where he served for more than a quarter of a century, always in attendance every Sunday until his recent illness prevented it. The Ripley United Brethren has received a heavy blow in the death of Dr. Casto, not alone from a financial point of view but more particularly from a standpoint of his christian influence and faithfulness to duty in whatever official position he held.

In early life he attended the pne room counrty school and after completing the elementary subjects he attended summer normal schools and at a very youthful age was granted a first grade teacher's certificate and taught school for a time. He took a great interest in the educational work of the county and served on the County Board of Examiners, which then licensed teachers. His father, in addition to being a minister, was a physician of prominence in Jackson, Roane and Kanawha counties and was very successful and so it is natural that his son, Dr. V. L. Casto, turned his attentions to the medical field, attending the medical school at the University of Louisville, Kentucky, from which he graduated with honors with the class of 1887-1888. He later took a post-graduate course in one of the large medical schools in Chicago in 1907. He at once entered the practice of his profession at Staats Mills and later came to Ripley, death has just ended a career of forty-eight (48) years for him as a physician in which he was eminently successful and known and loved throughout this part of the state.

Dr. Casto's grandfather, George Casto, was a member of the first county court in Jackson County and was one of it's very earliest sheriffs. In this respect we find his grandson, Dr. V. L. Casto, following in his footsteps as he was elected and served in the State Legislature in 1888-89, was a member of the United States Pension Board for a period of twelve (12) years, was a member of the Ripley Town Council for several years and for many years served as the Town Recorder when a number of the major improvements were made in the town. He was one of the leaders in urging the erection of our present high school building and new court house and in the paving of the streets of the town. (Jackson Herald, 14 Aug 1936)

Robert W.
