Gee, I have been up to so much lately, I don't know where to begin....

First, an apology. The newsletter is waaaay late this time but for good reason. Even before I published the last issue, I was busy researching the Castos of Upshur County. I've put more information about this elsewhere in this newsletter but, my goodness, are there a lot of Castos and descendents over there!

Second, I did a nice little piece of research for a fella from Alaska on his line which led more into the Caplinger family than it did Castos. He was looking for Hazel Kuplinger who married William C. Casto (1889-1978). It turns out she was Hazel Caplinger, daughter of William & Arminta (Clegg) Caplinger, b. Aug., 1895, d. about 1925.

Another piece of research led me to the Tenney Family Association (www.tenneyfamily.org). Even if you are not related to the family, it is an impressive effort put together by a lot of distant cousins all working together.

I also was contacted by Angelo and Corrado Casto from Noto, Sicily, Italy. They were asking how to find out about their own genealogy since in 1693 Noto was devastated by an earthquake and World War II didn't help with the record-keeping, either. I did some research and suggested they check with church records that may have been kept in other parts of Italy. This led me to research all of the Castos who came through Ellis Island. I published those findings on page three of this issue.

I frequently get requests from all over the place about how to find a certain Casto line. It is very rewarding for me when I am

able to help identify a family and get someone started on their own ancestry research. I'm currently helping a 14-year-old boy from Pennsylvania whose father died when he was only two so he didn't know much about his Casto ancestors. Not only do I get the pleasure of helping him, but I encouraged him to spend more time talking with his grandparents, which I'm sure pleased them, too! Plus, I'm throwing in a little American history and the how's and why's of U.S. census records.

As you can see, I am kept plenty busy with researching the Castos. Actually, a little too busy. I know many of you will be very unhappy to learn that the October issue (no. 25) will be the last of the *Casto Connections* newsletters. I'm afraid that the process involved in researching, writing, editing, publishing, keeping up with all the subscriptions, address changes, and queries has become too labor intensive for one person to do properly by themselves. Now, that I am involved in two major projects—the Castos on the U.S. Census & the Castos of Upshur County—I'm just not going to have time to publish the newsletter. However, the web site will still operate as always, and will actually benefit from any new research that I do. Anyone who is receiving this issue will receive the last one as well, and if any of the subscribers has paid up past October, I'll be sure to refund their unused money. I've enjoyed doing the newsletter and I know I've grown tremendously as both a researcher and a person while learning the ropes and getting to know so many wonderful distant cousins. This "idea" has grown well beyond any expectations I may have had six years ago and I feel very fortunate to have you as my teachers, my inspiration, and my friends.

Casto Connections—Keeping You Up-To-Date

Reader Response to our last issue:

As you may recall, the April, 2003 issue had the second part of an article on the New Jersey Castos. Here were some of the comments I heard:

Whatever Happened to the Castos of New Jersey:

(edited for length): Ina Tuft (inatuft@scinternet.net): You certainly do get better with each issue of *Casto Connections*. Suppose you have already found that on page 4 you gave Jeremiah s/o William & Sarah a sp of Naomi Brown instead of Hannah (?Smith) but doubt anyone noticed but me. And the comment that Naomi died in 1847 but I didn't see her on the 1840 census, " She is definitely not shown on the 1840 for Jacob. Don't think I am criticizing you -- these Castos are a nightmare to keep straight and we both know it. (Ina's right—when I created the table on page 4, I copied the wrong info into it. I've fixed in for future reference.)

On page 2, where Pat Rinebarger is still researching her Mary/Amy born about 1829. And she married John R. Cunningham April 1849. When I read that I seemed to remember that the marriage showed that her father was dead. I looked up what I had copied from the previous CC and sure enough that was what Pat had said. Well, you show Thomas Casto and his wife Marie in the 1860 census on page 3, so if that is the case that eliminates Thomas as her father. I have that Mark died at sea in 1855, and that his wife married Henry Robinson. I don't have the date they married, but the 1860 census shows Henry Robinson and Hannah so the 1855 date could be right. So that makes it so Amy/Mary is probably not the daughter of either Thomas or Mark.

I do hope that there is a listing of Thomas in 1850. I do have one for Thomas for 1860 and if there is one for 1850, we might get at least one more of the names of his children.

1860 New Jersey Census—Camden County—Winslow Twp.—Page 432:

Thomas Casto	50
Marie "	50

We know Mark had a daughter Martha who was married to Charles Dixon in 1852, but she was not listed in the 1850 census with his family. But there could be another child prior to Martha. I show a son, with no info on him. If Mark died earlier than 1855, I guess Amy/Mary could be their child.

I rather lean to her being a daughter of Daniel, with all the confusion of his two wives, and the letters I had from some of their descendants, where it states that Rowansy (Rosanna) was buried in Philadelphia. Because Amy/Mary did live in Philadelphia.

Danita's Note: I found the reference to the marriage of Martha Casto to Charles Dixon on August 20, 1852 in Winslow Twp., Camden County, NJ. The source for this was an IGI record for the Records of Births, Marriages, and Deaths of New Jersey 1848-1900 found on The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints web site (www.familysearch.org). I then found Charles and Martha on the 1860 Gloucester Co., NJ census (Franklin Twp., p. 245) with children William H. 6, Sarah Ann 4, Anna M. 2, and Charles 1 mo. Martha must have died between 1860 and 1866 because I found reference to a marriage between Charles Dixon and Louisa Mather on Jan. 2, 1866 in Cumberland Co., NJ and on the 1870 Cumberland Co., NJ Census, there was Charles Dickson, 44, with wife Louisa 34, son William 16, father Anthony 84, and possibly mother-in-law, Mary Matthews 57. I was hoping to locate something to tie Martha in to the Castos but she wasn't with Mark's family in 1850. There is obviously still a LOT of work to be done on the NJ Castos, especially the female lines.



For those of you who are wondering, we did not have our Casto Genealogy Conference in April in Cincinnati because not enough people registered to attend. There were going to be less than 10 people there, including Eileen Vickers and her family all the way from North Carolina. We'll have to think about this idea again in the future.

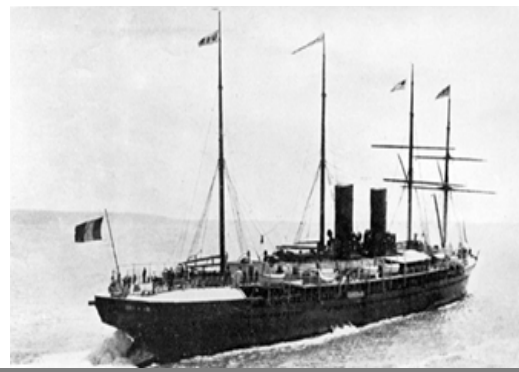


Were the Castos Italian?

This is the question that has been bounced around since the 1700's. Where did the Castos come from? Were they originally Castos or did they have another, similar sounding name? Where can we find definitive answers? Well, I don't know the answer to any of those questions but since it is important to our research, I wanted to throw these questions "out there" once again. Also, I have been contacted again by Castos from Europe who want to know about *their* ancestry. Seems that the two World Wars were a little bit hard on the records over there and they don't know where to look for leads. These Castos were from a little town in Sicily called Noto. Their request got me looking at various information on Italian Castos and what I could find out about them.

There is no doubt that there is a strong line of Italian Castos. Just as there is no doubt that there were Castos from other countries, as well. I created a database of all the Castos who came through Ellis Island. As many of you know, Ellis Island was the gateway from which over 12 million immigrants entered the United States from 1892 to 1954.

One interesting item I noted when I put together my Ellis Island information. The records listed the passenger's name, their age, their ship, date of arrival, and port of departure. In some of the records, you could actually find a picture of the ship they arrived in. Can you imagine being able to see the actual ship your ancestor came to America on? Of course, the Castos that came over during this time period were 200 years after the earliest Castos in America and probably have no connection to them at all, but I found it interesting to note where they came from. If 90% of the Castos came from Italy, and 10% from several other countries in Europe, does that mean our Castos were Italian? No, because we are looking for just one line, one person, one little boy, stowaway, hostage, or pirate, depending on which version of the story you believe. Our ancestor could be in that 10% category. However, since our readership is now spreading to other countries, some of these later arrivals need to be looked at. In one startling case, Giovanni Casto arrived in America on *The La Bourgogne*, from Le Havre, Seine-Inferior, France on June 26, 1898. Only a week later, on July 4, 1898, the ship sank following a collision off Newfoundland with a loss of 549 lives. I wonder if his descendents know how close to tragedy he came. In another interesting case I found, Juan Casto arrived on August 15, 1921 aboard the *Eugene V.R. Thayer* as a member of the crew. Juan was of Spanish origin and was 36 years old. Three days later, the ship *Yucatan* arrived, with a crewman also named Juan Casto. This Juan was 45 years old and listed as being colored from Ecuador!

The number of Castos who came through Ellis Island totaled 126. This does not seem like a whole lot, especially considering the time span researched. That number, however, was only the records for exact matches for CASTO. If I had included various spellings, the number jumped to 1068 and included everything from Casto to Castor, Caston, Castorina, etc. I was able to find this information on-line at <http://www.ellisland.org>. It is a free database but keep in mind the time period covered is 1892 to 1954. It also does not answer questions like, "Did these people stay in the U.S.?", "What other ports might they arrived in?", or "Did they already have family in the U.S.?" But if you know you have immigrants ancestors who came to the United States during that time period, it is an invaluable tool. Another item to note when using the database is that the place noted as "Residence" can vary depending on how that person answered the question. One person might have said "Noto" whereas another might have said "Noto, Sicily" or just "Sicily".

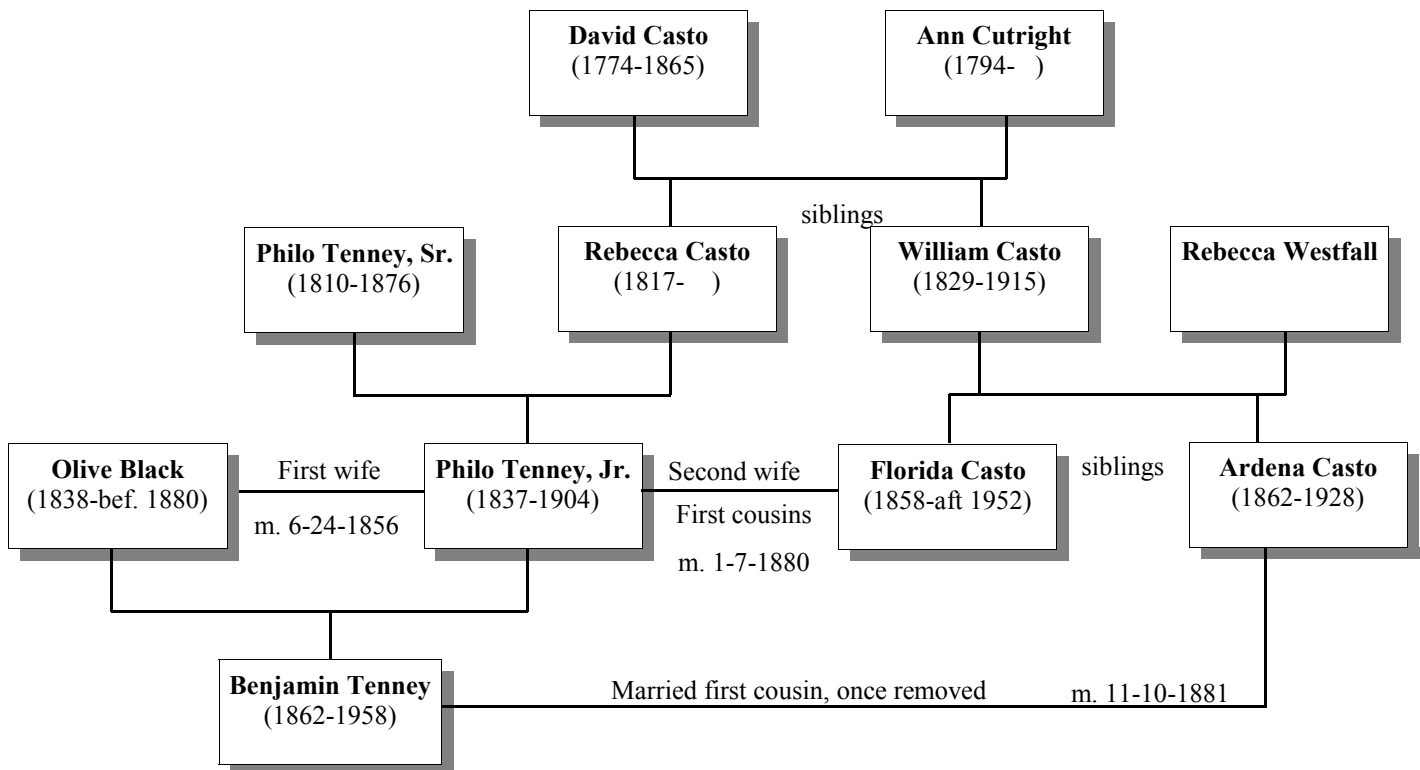

Have You Ever Felt Like, “Boy, I Stepped in it Now!”?

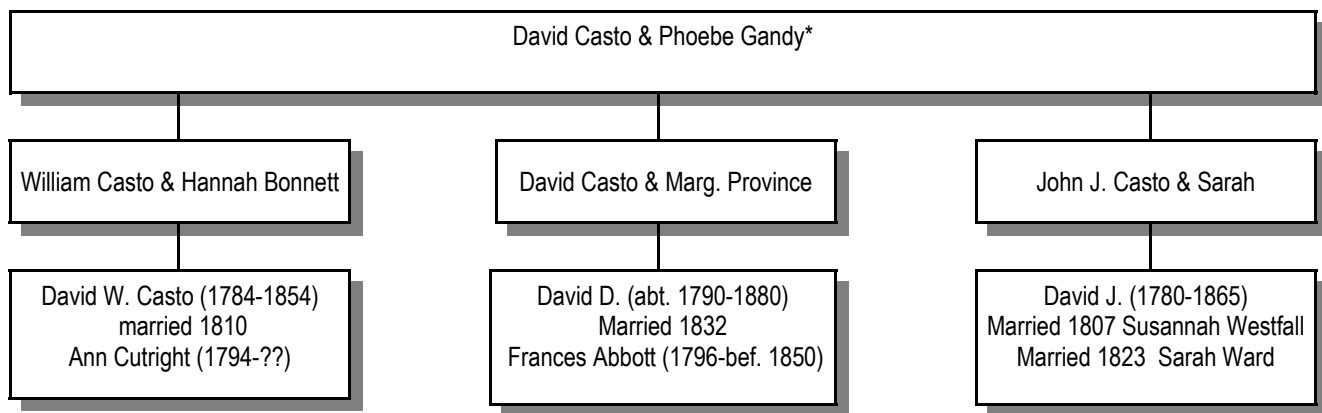
I was recently working on the Upshur County, West Virginia line of Castos when I decided to go through the indices of the two new Upshur County Marriage Books I had just bought and see how many Castos I could enter into my database. As with many other genealogy projects, I didn't get very far until I hit a snag. Boy, was this one a doozy!!! Ardena Casto, daughter of William Casto and Rebecca Westfall married Benjamin Tenney on Nov. 10, 1881. As a matter of course, I entered Benjamin's parents into my database as well—Philo L. & Olive Tenney. Gee, but that name—Philo—sounded familiar. Well, it turns out that Philo was actually Philo Tenney, Jr., son of Philo Tenney & Rebecca Casto! Rebecca was the daughter of David W. Casto and Ann Cutright. But, wait! If Benjamin was the granddaughter of Rebecca Casto and his wife was a Casto, were they related? Well, naturally! They were first cousins, once removed. Here is where it started to get deep:

Apparently, Philo Tenney, Sr. married Rebecca Casto in 1834. Their son, Philo Jr., married twice—first to Olive Black, second to Florida Casto. Florida was the daughter of William Casto and Rebecca Westfall, too. Philo & Florida's son, Benjamin, married Ardena Casto. As it turns out, the name “Tenney” is about as common in Upshur County as “Casto” is to Jackson County!

As I demonstrated on the previous page, the Castos that lived in Upshur County can be just as confusing to research as those of Jackson County. And even though some of our readers are deeply involved with researching these lines, I had never fully appreciated the complexity and number of Castos over there until I start doing my own research on them. Using the many tools available to genealogists (census, birth, death, marriage, land, wills, etc.), I worked these lines as thoroughly as I possibly could. At last count, this has led to over 600 direct descendents of David J. Casto alone, not including spouses. I originally was planning a nice little article for the newsletter on these lines. Then I had to start setting aside articles I had already written because the article kept growing. Then it was the entire newsletter devoted to it. I even held up publication while I tried to make even a small amount fit. Now, it is so large that I believe a separate publication is needed just for this body of work.
