I Isaac S.Caste of Staats Mills in the County of Jackson and State of West Virginia, farmer, being of sound mind and memory, do make publish and declare this to be my last will and testament, and as to my worldly estate, and all the property, real and personal to which I shall be entitled at the time of my decease, I devise, bequeath and dispose thereof in the manner following, to-wit:

My will is that all my just debts and funeral expenses shall by my executors hereinafter named be paid out of my estate as soon after my decease as shall by them be found convenient.

I give devise and bequeath to my beloved wife, Sarah J. Caste all my personal property, ~~as long as she remains my widow or for the term of her natural life and at her death~~ ^{And Real Property} my real estate to be divided equally between my two sons Owens Caste and Ola Caste and Should oil gas or mineral be produced from the above mentioned real estate, My Will is that the proceeds be divided equally among my wife and heirs namely as follows; Sarah J. Caste, Anna Anderson, Maggie Caste, Limon Caste, Clara Keebaugh, Stella Caste, Owens Caste and Ola Caste,

And lastly I do nominate and appoint my said sons, Owens Caste and Ola Caste to be the executors of this my last will and testament.

In witness whereof I the said Isaac S. Caste have to this my last will and testament Consisting of one sheet of paper subscribed my name and affixed my seal, this 25 day of April 1916.
